Thanks for participating in **Video Fest '10**. The theme for the competition is, "**Be Nice to Mother Nature.**" It's a broad category, have fun with it.

The maximum length is 12 (twelve) minutes, shorter is OK. There is a \$5 (five dollars) entry fee and prizes for best video, best script, best music, best special effects and honorable mention.

The festival is open to Colorado students, grades 6 to 12. Entries will be judged by local professionals in the arts and film and video production. Entries are judged on originality around the theme and technical expertise. **There is a 1st place prize of \$100, 2nd place \$50 and 3rd place \$25**

The awards presentation will be at the Broomfield Auditorium in November 2010. More details to follow.
